SASKFILM BOARD OF DIRECTORS APPOINTS ACTING CHIEF EXECUTIVE OFFICER AND FILM COMMISSIONER

Regina, SK (December 15, 2005)— The SaskFilm Board of Directors announced today the appointment of Susanne Bell as acting Chief Executive Officer and Film Commissioner of SaskFilm effective immediately. The appointment is in response to the departure of Valerie Creighton, the Corporation's current CEO and Film Commissioner, who was recently appointed as President of the Canadian Television Fund. The SaskFilm Board of Directors will proceed to communicate their plans for a permanent appointment in the coming months.

"On behalf of the SaskFilm Board of Directors, we are pleased to appoint Susanne as acting CEO and Film Commissioner during this period of transition at SaskFilm," said Pamela Haidenger-Bains, Chair of the SaskFilm Board of Directors. "Her intimate knowledge of the industry and her ability to forge new relationships will ensure a smooth transition in operations and continuation of services to support and promote the film and television industry in Saskatchewan."

As Director of Programs and Services at SaskFilm for almost seven years, Ms. Bell was responsible for the implementation and management of a wide range of programs and services of the Corporation including: market development, soundstage operations; identification and analysis of provincial, national and international industry issues; providing recommendations for implementation of policy or action required by the Corporation; developing and implementing improvements to program and administrative guidelines, policies and procedures; developing and managing SaskFilm's annual budget and acting in the capacity of CEO in the absence of the CEO. Prior to her appointment at SaskFilm, she has held many positions in the film and television industry ranging from production coordinator to producer.
